Tone Quality

- The character of musical tones with reference to their richness or perfection
 - o Center of tone and pitch
 - Breath support and control
 - Balance and blend when playing with others
 - Foreground: melody
 - Background: chordal harmony

Flat and Sharp


- A flat lowers the pitch by a half step. If you are flat push in your tuning slide, barrel, mouthpiece, etc.
- A sharp raises the pitch by a half step. If you are sharp, pull out your tuning slide, barrel, mouthpiece, etc.
- In general cold band instruments play flat (thus why we warm up)
- When playing loud band instruments tend to play flat, and hen playing soft band instruments tend to play sharp
- When playing a crescendo instruments tend to go flat, and when playing a decrescendo band instruments tend to go sharp.
